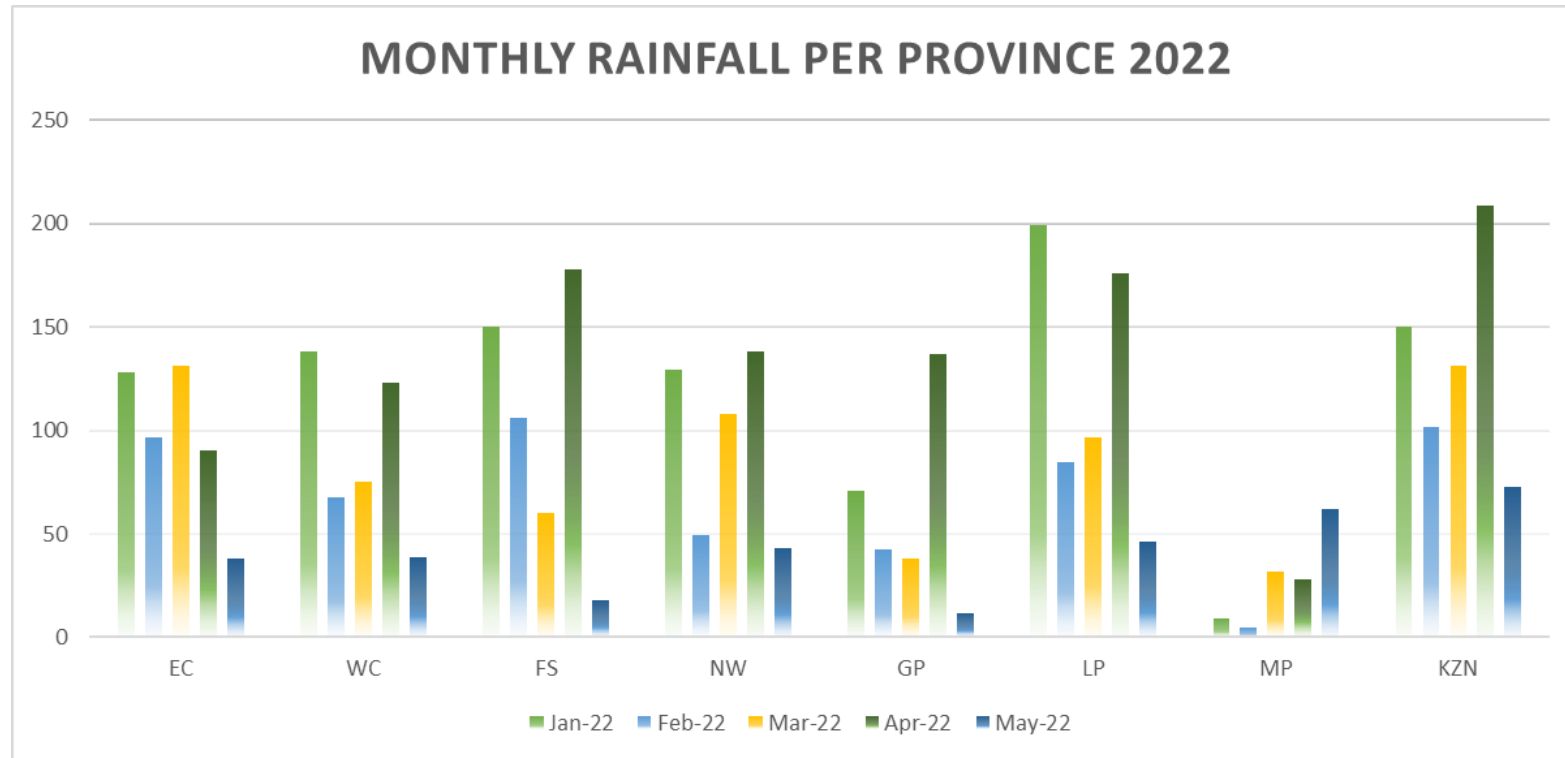


South African Year to Date Summer Rainfall Report

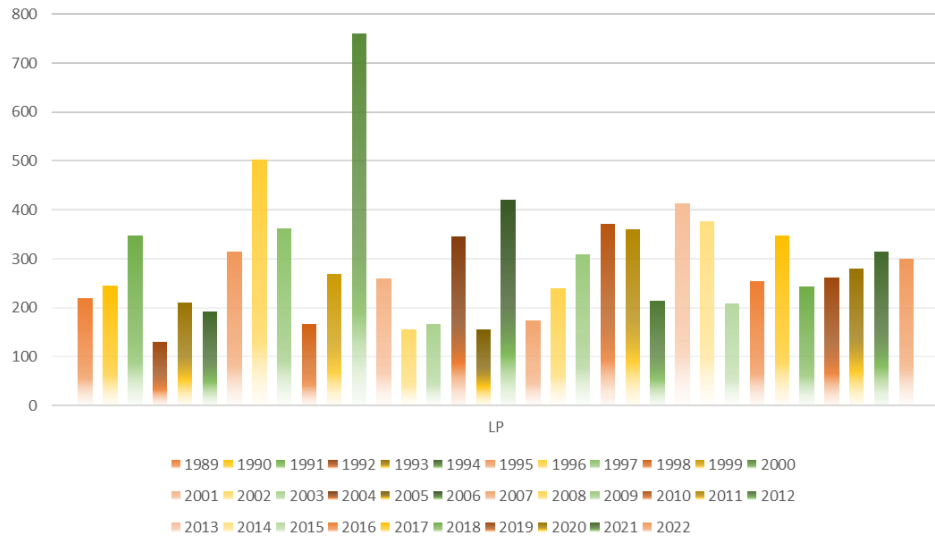

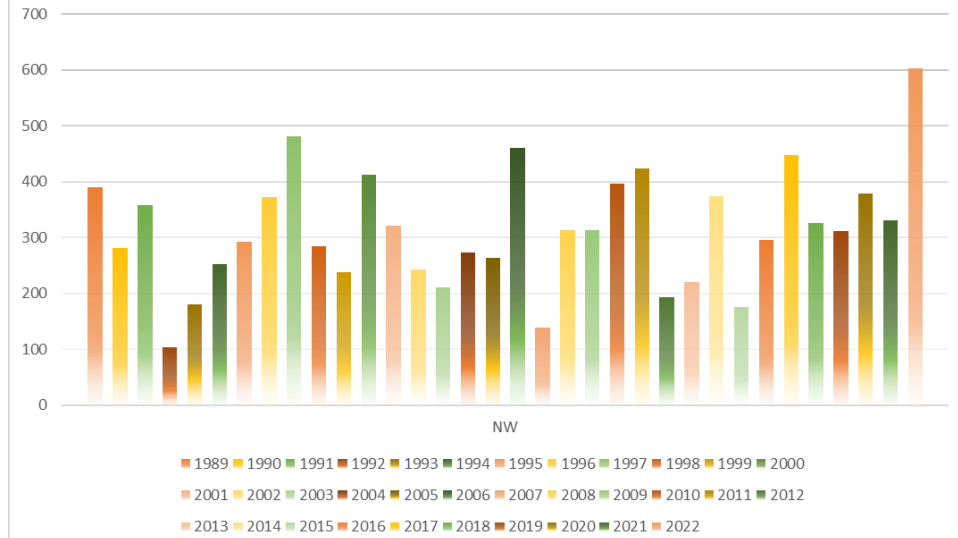
2022 can be classified as a wet year, still influenced by the El Nino. The El Nino will also contribute to the cold winter fronts ahead for the winter season. The new summer rainfall can be expected from August/September 2022, again expecting a wet rainfall season.

Outlook for the 2022/2023 summer grain season: even though input costs are rising constantly, farmers are motivated to take advantage of the good soil moisture due to above average rainfall since December last year. Soybean and Sunflower hectares are expected to increase, and Maize hectares are expected to decrease due to less expensive input costs on the oilseed side.

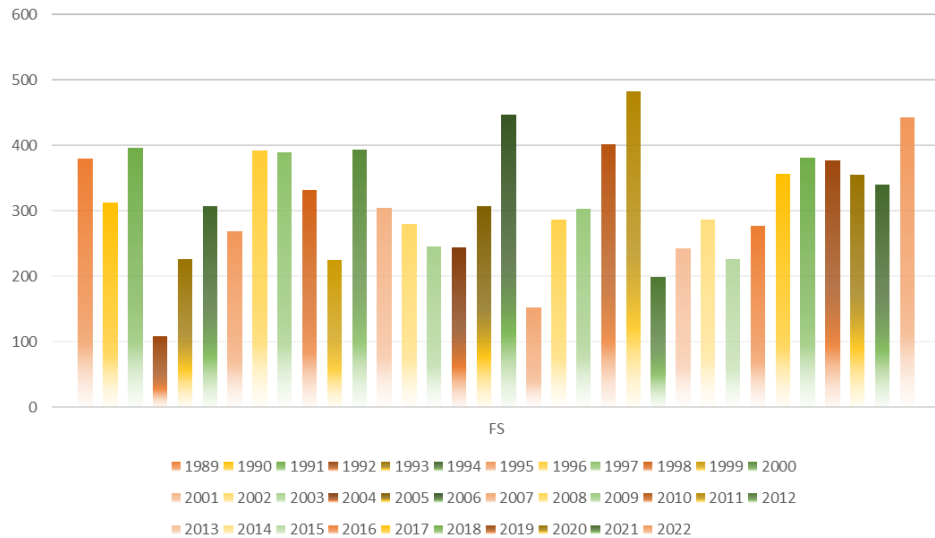

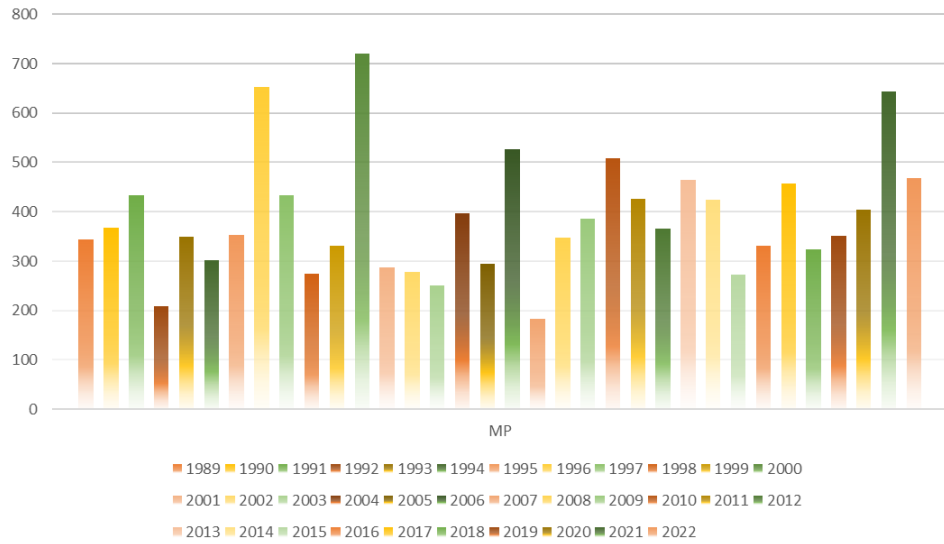

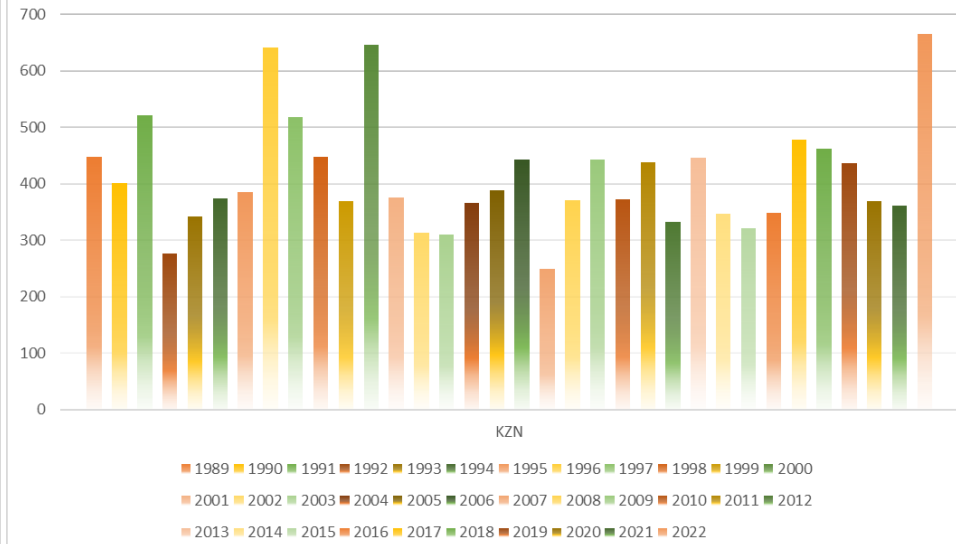

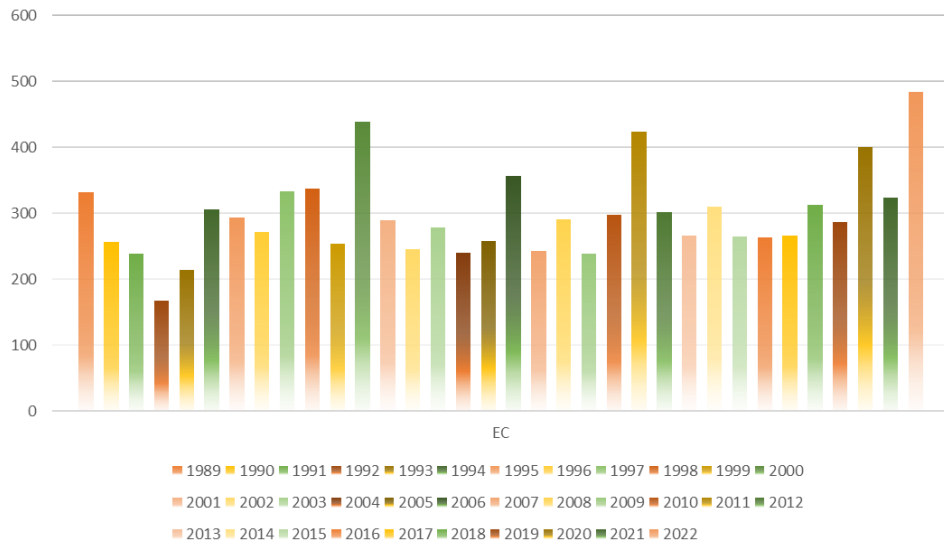
RAINFALL YEAR TO DATE MP
